Directions from Chehalis. Go south on I-5 about 14 miles to exit 63. Take exit 63 toward Winlock/ Toledo. Turn left onto 505 E. Go about 16 miles. Turn left onto 504 E. Go about 28 miles. Take a slight left onto 504E/Spirit Lake Hwy. Go about 0.3 miles. Turn left again to stay on Spirit Lake Hwy. 318 feet to lake.
