Dr. Jacob Probhakar is an ophthalmologist and medical director of Ruby Nelson Memorial Hospital—an Adventist institution in northern India. He and the hospital have created a unique humanitarian program that provides cataract surgery to thousands in destitute rural communities. Dr. Jacob performs over 11,000 cataract procedures a year free-of-charge to people who are blinded by their condition. His biggest challenge is the overwhelming number of people waiting for treatment. So he has trained himself to do 1½ minute cataract surgeries—sometimes performing more than 400 a day.
