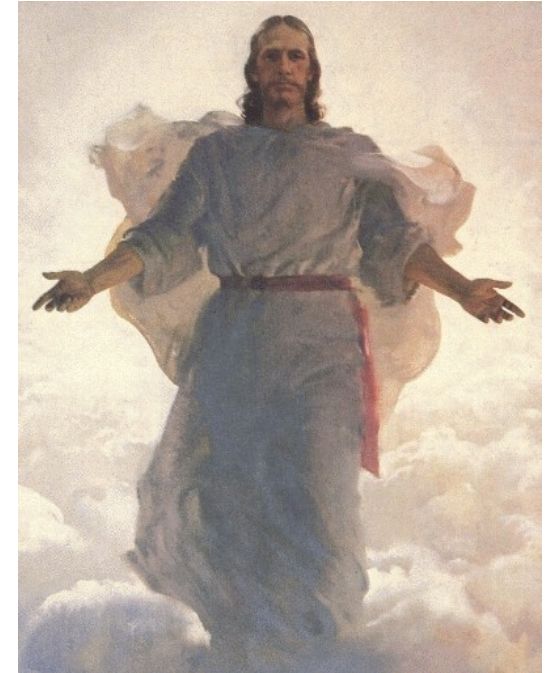

Justin Heinrich Knecht (1752-1817), a German composer, organist, and music theorist, was born and spent most of his career in Biberach, a town in the south of Germany. He served as organist at St. Martin's Church, which was used simultaneously by both Lutherans and Catholics. He led a busy musical life, composing for both the theater and church, organizing concerts, and teaching music related subjects at the local Gymnasium. His music sounds similar to that of his contemporaries, Mozart and Haydn.
