## We Believe in God the Holy Spirit

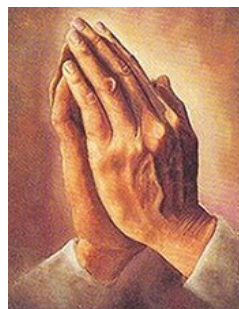

Fanny Hensel (née Mendelssohn–Bartholdy) was a child prodigy equally talented as her more famous brother, Felix, but her family expected her not to publish her music lest the public’s demands for attention detract from her responsibilities as wife and mother. She wrote this piece for her own wedding, literally the night before, staying up until after midnight, when the music promised by her brother failed to arrive. But the piece was not published until 1996.
