We Believe in the Word of God

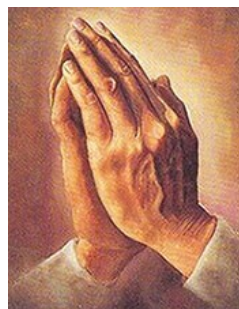
